James R. Carey is a distinguished professor of entomology at the University of California (UC), Davis and senior scholar at the Center for the Economics and Demography of Aging at UC Berkeley. One of his main disciplinary interests over most of his four-decade career has been on the biodemography of aging. Dr. Carey is the former director of an 11-university NIH-funded program titled “Biodemographic Determinants of Life Span” and the author of nearly 300 journal articles or book chapters. He is one of the few biologists known for a discovery in mathematical demography (Carey’s Equality—life lived equals life left in stationary populations).
